


The perfection of Sorry Giotto among the excellences of Opera Italiana

Catellani & Smith will exhibit the 'circle – light sculpture', which hides behind his minimal hand-painted structure a ring of high-powered LEDs that illuminate and create light effects on the wall space. Sorry Giotto will be presented in three different diameters: 60, 90, 120 cm.
